

Provincial Growth Fund Job Data as at 31 May 2019

The Provincial Development Unit (PDU) collects part-time and full-time job numbers which will be reported quarterly. As at 31 May 2019, 1,023 people were employed in PGF-supported projects. This consists of a mix of 730 full-time and 293 part-time roles. These people were employed at the time of data collection and the figure is not a cumulative total.

The Provincial Growth Fund was launched in early 2018 and is in its second year of operation. The PDU is now looking to expand the breadth of data it gathers and develop a more thorough data collection process as projects come to fruition.
